Sam D - I liked it when we painted the cats and it was nice being with different children

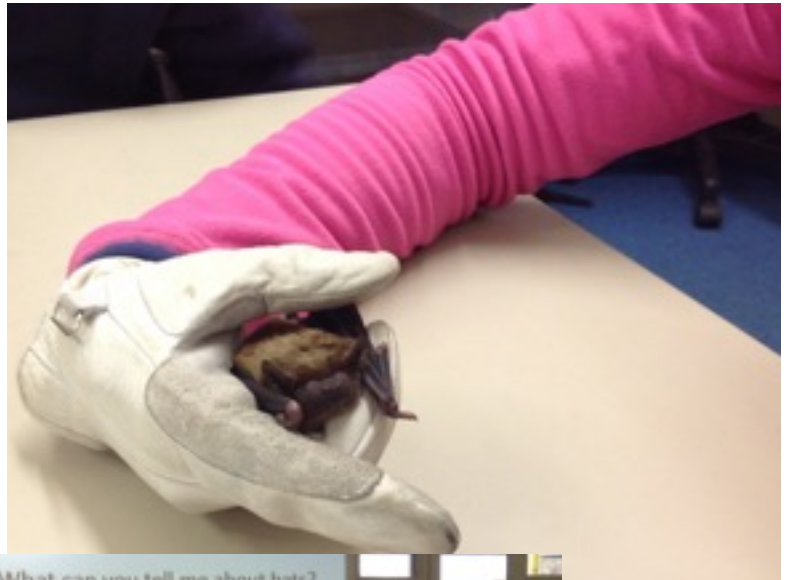
Monty - I really enjoyed it and my favourite bit was when we looked at the story again
